### Computer Lab

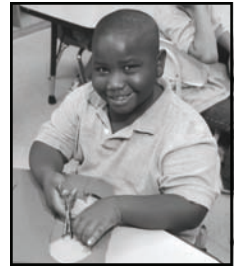
Computers are available for kids during designated hours for homework, games and educational research. Youth will also learn a wide range of subjects in computers and technology.

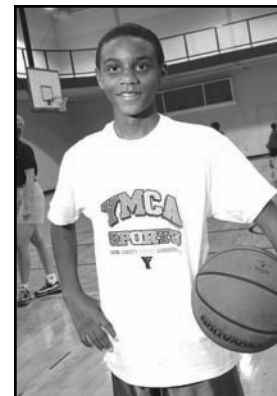


## Fitness
